As a graduate student, taught four classes as the only Computer Networking Instructor at ITT Technical Institute. The classes and their content were as follows:

- Introduction to Computers
 - Computer History: The history of hardware, software, and the internet.
 - Hardware: What is hardware and its individual components including peripherals. I routinely supervised students breaking down and setting up systems for class group exercises.
 - Software: Drivers and operating systems.
- Introduction to Networking: Topics included terminology and matching networks with a variety of business environments. Terminology included tools, cables, and connectors.
- Networking 1 & 2: The courses examined the concepts of upgrading and maintaining computer network systems in LAN/WAN/MAN environments. Students learned terminology, and protocols, in addition to working in teams to create virtual networks on external hard drives using Windows Server 2008 R2 (Active Directory).
